The Secretary of the Army has reposed special trust and confidence in the patriotism, valor, fidelity, and professional excellence of Charles B. Wurm. In view of these qualities and his demonstrated leadership potential and dedicated service to the U.S. Army, he is therefore promoted from Specialist to Sergeant. MOS 31R2000YY is awarded as his primary MOS effective 1 April 2003. Promotion is effective 1 April 2003 with a date of rank 1 April 2003. Promotion is not valid and it will be revoked if he is not in a promotable status on the effective date of promotion. The authority for this promotion is paragraph 3-34, AR 600-8-19, U.S. Total Army Personnel Command Memorandum, TAPC-MSP-E, dated 10 October 2002 for the 1 November 2002 promotions. **Special Instructions:** "Soldier has not met the NCOES requirement and is promoted conditionally. If the soldier does not attend and successfully complete PLDC as scheduled, not to exceed 12 months from the effective date of this order, the soldier will be administratively reduced and will be required to reappear before a promotion board to regain promotable status."
